

Child Care information for Children Ages 4 and under

Priority for children of first responders and emergency service workers.

School districts throughout Suffolk County have been collaborating with the Child Care Council of Suffolk (CCCS) to assist families in finding appropriate child care for children ages 4 and under.

There are currently 195 licensed and registered child care programs open and available to serve children under age 5 in Suffolk County. County-wide the number of spots available are:

383 slots for infants (up to 18 months)
662 slots for toddlers (under 3 years)
903 slots for preschoolers (3 and 4 years old)

In addition, the Stony Brook Child Care Center is open for SBU Hospital employees, with capacity to serve up to 80 children under age 5.

Any essential worker needing child care will be referred to the CCCS hotline at 646-926-3748 to be connected with a referral specialist who will identify available programs that meet each parent's needs.
